Making Sense of Sensory Processing

Accurately interpreting sensory information is essential to understanding and responding accurately to one's environment. This workshop reviews the major senses: vision, hearing, taste, smell and touch, as well as the "hidden" senses of proprioception and vestibular.

Attendees will learn about typical sensory development, the effect of sensory processing challenges on motor development, self modulation and learning, some of the typical behaviors which result from challenges in sensory processing, and strategies to improve sensory integration.
